Fruit ripens from mid-July with a very long cropping period.

Fruit Quality

Very large, shiny fruit with excellent blackberry-aroma. Unlike most other varieties the berries of Asterina® do not taste sour even when not quite ripe. Plant Characteristics

Upright growing with numerous shoots and sufficient young shoots for the following year. The plant is thornless.

Disease Resistance

Plants of Asterina® are generally very healthy, with no particular susceptibility to pests or diseases having been recorded to date.
