## Fruit Quality

The fruits are well presented, very pale orange red in colour, without going dark after picking. The berries are short conical shaped, with a good size (av. 4.5g to 5g). Berries have very good firmness and shelf life, a week after picking the fruit still looks good in store. Fruit Yield

Chambord has very high fruit yields. Good potential for double cropping (Spring and Autumn).

## Plant Characteristics

Chambord canes have small spines and are very vigorous. Flowering occurs at the end of the cane, which results in a drooping habit.

## Disease Resistance

Chambord is tolerant to all the main diseases and pests.
